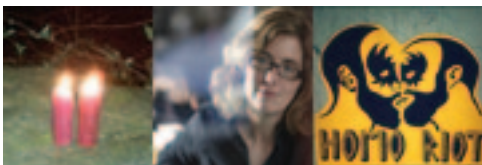
Sean Hill, Editor
